



## AWARDS & CRITERIA ~ STUDENT ART CONTEST 2018 COVINGTON THREE RIVERS ART FESTIVAL

### AWARDS

**BEST OF SHOW**—Ribbon and \$50 CASH in four levels (elementary, middle, junior high & high school).

**FIRST, SECOND, THIRD PLACE AND HONORABLE MENTION**—Ribbons in each medium in each grade. Each first place winner in each grade will receive a gift of art supplies from Mo's Art Supply and Framing, 315 N Columbia St, Covington.

**MICHELANGELO AWARD**—Ribbon and Plaque presented by American Society of Italian Heritage to one "Michelangelo" student award winner in each of the four levels.

**"ARTIST'S FAVORITE" AWARD**—Ribbon for one entry selected by a local professional artist

### CRITERIA

**ELIGIBILITY:** ALL St. Tammany Parish students in K-12 (public, private, parochial or home schools)

**ENTRIES:** ONLY ONE entry per student in either 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional category. Artwork must be the ORIGINAL work of the student entrant.

**JURIED EXHIBIT:** Student artwork will be juried. In addition to winning artwork, a minimum of several hundred pieces of selected student art will be displayed, as space permits. Artwork not meeting size and/or other requirements will not be displayed.

**MEDIA:** Any media of 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional artwork. NO PHOTOGRAPHY. NO DIGITAL ART.

**SIZE: 2-D:** From 8 ½" X 11" to 18" X 24" maximum size limit (including mat & border on 2-D work).

**3-D:** No more than 24" high X 24" wide X 24" deep. This is the maximum size for 3-D art.

**REQUIREMENTS:** NO GLASS OR FRAMES ALLOWED ON ANY ARTWORK.

- All 2-dimensional work on paper must be matted and labeled.
- Pastels and charcoals must be sprayed to avoid smearing.
- Stretched canvases must be ready to hang with screw eyes and wire only (no saw tooth hangers).
- Art may be hung with pushpins through the matting or using Velcro tabs attached to the back.
- Entrants may submit art with additional border around mat, but overall size must not exceed maximum size limit of 18"x 24".

- Each 3-Dimensional work must be able to stand for display. A tabletop stand or easel must accompany 3-D artwork that cannot stand on its own.

**LABEL:** Complete only one label for **FRONT** of each piece of artwork entered. Label **MUST BE COMPLETED** and firmly attached to front of artwork, or attached to 3-D entries with a string or tag hanging from artwork.

*NOTE: Labels indicating name/school of entrant will be covered during judging and the covering will be removed after festival judges have selected winning artwork.*

## **DATES & DEADLINES**

**ART DROP-OFF:** Sunday, Nov 4th from 11-5 pm, at the Heritage Bank, 201 North Columbia Street, Covington, LA. No art accepted after Sunday, November 4th.

*NOTE: Reasonable care will be exercised to ensure safety and security of artwork. By submitting an entry, entrants agree to hold harmless festival officials and/or volunteers for any damage to or loss of artwork.*

**FESTIVAL DATES:** Saturday Nov 10 & Sunday, Nov 11, from 10 am-5 pm daily

**STUDENT ART EXHIBIT:** Saturday, Nov 10 from 10 am-5 pm & Sunday, Nov 11 from 10 am-2 pm in Heritage Bank, 201 North Columbia Street.

*NOTE: Exhibit closes on Sunday at 2pm for presentation of awards and artwork pickup (3-5 pm)*

**PRESENTATION OF AWARDS:** Awards presented & names of all winners announced on Sunday, Nov 11 at 2:00 pm at Heritage Bank.

**ART PICK-UP (MANDATORY):** Sunday, Nov 11, from 3-5 pm in Heritage Bank, 201 North Columbia Street.

*NOTE: The festival assumes no responsibility for artwork not picked up on Sunday during scheduled pick-up time.*
